A world premiere! The Orchestre de la Suisse Romande in Hologram form A Symphonic Odyssey by icologram[®]

GENEVA, December 20, 2023 – The Orchestre de la Suisse Romande is delighted to announce that it will be giving the first hologram symphony concert ever recorded. As part of the 12th edition of the artgenève fair, which will take place from 25 to 28 January 2024, 73 musicians will take virtual shape to perform the Pictures at an Exhibition by Moussorgski. This is a first for the Orchestre de la Suisse Romande, which is exploring new ways of broadcasting classical music and reaching new audiences.

In collaboration with the company Cybel'Art, the Orchestra was filmed and captured from every angle: while performing the iconic piece of the classical repertoire: the majestic *Pictures at an Exhibition* by the composer Modest Moussorgski, in the biggest Theatre of Switzerland, the Théâtre de Beaulieu. Gestures, facial expressions, bow movements, silences - everything was captured using motion capture, a technology that can easily record the positions of the musicians and transposes them virtually. It is the first time that this extremely precise and meticulous technology and set design are used to film for a symphony orchestra. In 1954, the Orchestre de la Suisse Romande was a pioneer in this field, making the very first symphonic stereophonic recording under the baton of its conductor and founder Ernest Ansermet. 70 years later, in 2024, the OSR is once again the first symphony orchestra to experiment with a new means of broadcasting.

The matrix recorded in September 2023 will be used to develop an innovative online teaching module (accessible from the OSR website), enabling the public to interact with the Orchestra and discover the world of the OSR in a way that no other orchestra offers to date. The Orchestra is currently studying the possibilities to develop an application using a virtual reality headset, to enable a very wide audience - including "hindered" audiences - to experience the OSR in a different and immersive way.

Several performances of this first hologram symphony concert will be given as part of the artgenève fair taking place in Geneva from 25 to 28 January 2024.

Invented by Cybel'Art in 2019, the Icologram[®] technology is a revolutionary protocol in digital art and holography. The Orchestre de la Suisse Romande's icologram was created to embody the potential of extended reality (XR) and holography in symphonic music. This innovation now paves the way for immersive, cutting-edge symphonic experiences, marking not only a milestone in ArtTech but also redefining the way we experience music.

ANA MARÍA PATIŇO-OSORIO conductor



Born in Colombia in 1995, Ana María Patiño-Osorio obtained a bachelor's degree in orchestral conducting from the Universidad EAFIT in Medellín in 2017 after training as a saxophonist.

Since her appointment as Assistant Conductor of the Orchestre de la Suisse Romande for the 2022-23 season (extended for 2023-24), Ana María Patiño-Osorio has gathered praise as a remarkable conductor expressing wisdom, finesse, and deep respect for music. Chosen from nearly 300 candidates to work directly with Jonathan Nott and an elite roster of guest conductors, shortly after her appointment, in January 2023 she successfully stepped in at short notice to conduct the OSR featuring violinist Daniel Lozakovich and pianist Mikhail Pletnev as soloists. Of her conducting, Le Temps wrote: "the entire performance of Ana Maria Patino-Osorio impressed with her strength and her tranquillity of being."

Following on Ana Maria's recent successes, she has been invited to guest conduct in upcoming seasons orchestras such as Orchestre de Chambre de Lausanne, Iberacademy Orchestra at Mozart Festival in Salzburg, the National Symphony Orchestra of Colombia, Philharmonic of Bogota and the National Symphony of Uruguay. Her recent engagements included the Meininger Staatstheather, the École de Musique de Genève Orchestre, EAFIT Symphony Orchestra, Medellín Philharmonic Orchestra and the Youth Philharmonic Orchestra of Colombia among others.

artgenève

Launched in 2012, the artgenève art fair has carved out a place for itself on the European art fair calendar during the Geneva winter season. At the end of January, the fair welcomes a prestigious selection of some 70 international galleries. The programme is enriched by presentations from institutions, private collections, foundations and art schools. Local cultural players such as MAMCO, the Musée d'art et d'histoire, the Centre d'art contemporain, HEAD, and the Fonds Cantonaux and Fonds de la Ville de Genève will also be represented. Targeted international invitations complete the programme. Since 2012, a platform has been created especially for sound, performance and ephemeral works: artgenève/musique. This initiative highlights the power of creative expression through sound and performance, helping to enrich the artistic and immersive experience of artgenève. More than 40 new creations have been created as part of various projects in Geneva and abroad. artgeneve.ch
